The Student Governmental Affairs Program asked high school teachers what they thought about the SGAP program. Here are the results.

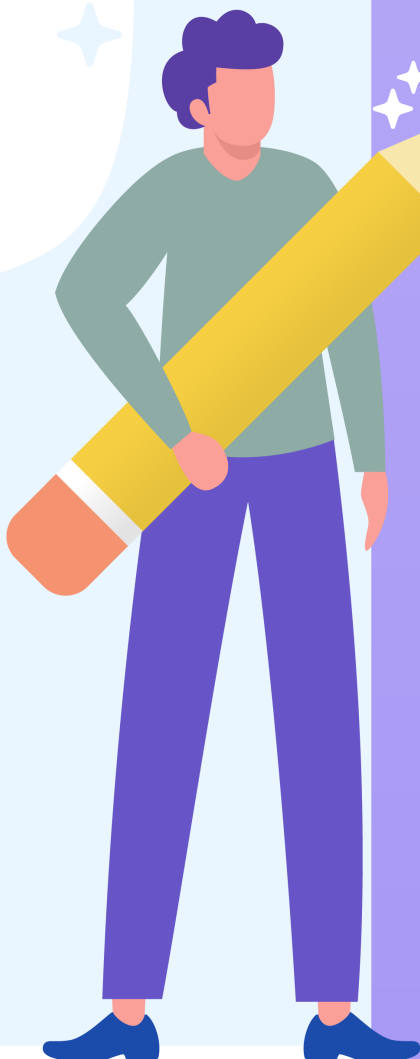

### How the 2024 Impact Survey Was Conducted

The survey was conducted Nov. 5-Nov. 20, 2024, via SurveyMonkey. Invitations were sent to 1,020 teachers enrolled in the SGAP program; of those, 107 responded. At a 95% confidence level, the margin of error for this sample size is 9%.
