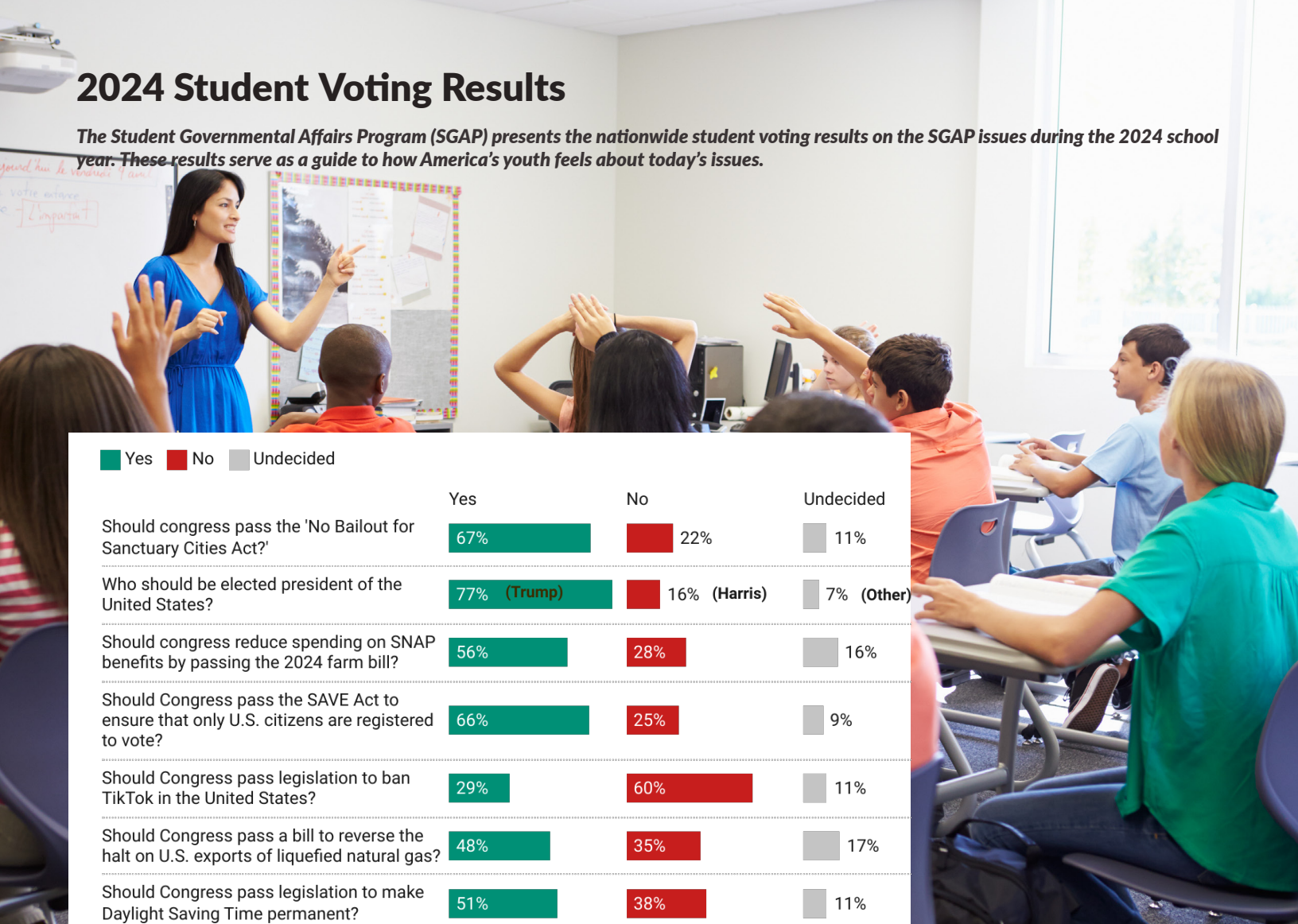


# 2024 Student Voting Results
